1. REGATTA OFFICE & FLAGPOLE

Competitor briefings will be held at the main flagmast outside of Island Brew Coffeehouse, 377 Keahole St #C2, Hawaii Kai.

Notice to Competitors Will be posted on the Team App

2. RULES

- **2.1.** The two-turns penalty in RRS 44.1 is replaced with a one turn-turn penalty.
- **2.2.** When AP is displayed ashore, RRS S4.2 is changed to "not less than 30 minutes"
- **2.3.** RRS S3.1 is deleted. Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted 90 minutes before the first scheduled race it effects. Any change made afloat will be identified with three sound signals. The change will be advised verbally.
- 3. SIGN ON SIGN OFFEach competitor shall sign on as instructed at the All Fleets Briefing / Skipper's Meeting to be held at 830hrs on Saturday March 14, 2020. Competitors shall sign off within 15 minutes of coming ashore at Ala Wai Harbor. A boat retiring shall inform the race committee as soon as possible.

5. The START

The start line is between the inflatable red pin and the race committee boat.

6. THE FINISH

The finish line will be between the last /farthest out red Ala Wai channel marker and a yellow triangular inflatable marker to the windward.

Competitors launching from Hawaii Kai municipal ramp (larger boats only)

For competitors originating or putting in vessels at the Hawaii Kai municipal ramp:

- 1. 7:30am Put in and fully rig your vessels at the Hawaii Kai Municipal ramp. Park your vehicle and trailers in the designated parking slips with in the Hawaii Kai municipal parking lot.
- 2. 8:00am Then sail your vessel east bound thru the channel markers to the "Berm Beach" (see photo). Which is located near the main big bridge and on the east side of the berm. Kiters can also setup here (walk down by bridge area).
- 3. Pull your vessel up on to the beach and pull your sail down but do not de-rig.
- 4. 8:15am An official escort boat will pick up all the skippers at 8:15am from Berm Beach to bring them to the skippers meeting at Hawaii Kai Boat Club.
- 5. 8:30am Skippers meeting.
- 6. 9:00am Return skipper back to Berm Beach
